PRIDE VENDOR MARKET AGREEMENT

Iowa City Pride Festival, June 12, 2004

In signing this agreement for the 2004 Iowa City PrideFest, Pride Market participants agree to each and all clauses set forth in this agreement. Failure by the Pride Market participants to abide by any clauses set forth in this agreement of the 2004 Iowa City Pride Festival gives Iowa City Pride and/or the authorized agents of Iowa City Pride the right to (1) immediately terminate this agreement (2) require Pride Market participant, immediately upon notice of violation of this agreement, to cease operations and vacate the premises, and (3) forfeit any and all fees paid to IOWA CITY PRIDE for the right and privilege of participating in the Pride Market of the 2004 Iowa City PrideFest. No clauses of this agreement may be changed in any way or altered without the written, signed permission of IOWA CITY PRIDE.

1. IOWA CITY PRIDE agrees to provide each Pride Market participant of the 2004 Iowa City Pride Festival with assigned space at the Pride Market of the 2004 Iowa City Pride Festival.
2. Pride Market participant's shall not display, offer for view or sell any illegal or contraband items. The laws of the State of Iowa and local ordinances of the City of Iowa City Johnson County shall control. Pride Market participants shall not display, offer for view or sell any items that are unlicensed and/or copies/interpretations of licensed or registered items at any and all sites and operations of the 2004 Iowa City Pride Festival.
3. Pride Market participants shall not display, offer for view, take orders for or sell any items that are imprinted, emblazoned or marked in any manner with the words **"2004 Iowa City PrideFest/Celebration."** Even when printed with other words, Pride Market participants shall not offer phrases, logos or artwork with any variations of these words.
4. Pride Market participants shall not sublet their space to anyone.
5. Pride Market participant acknowledges and understands that they are responsible for sales and use tax and shall in no way hold the IOWA CITY PRIDE or its representatives responsible for any type of permits other than for the festival itself.
6. Refund Policy: A 50% refund will be given to a written request received by June 1, 2004. No refunds will be given for any request received after June 1, 2004.
7. IOWA CITY PRIDE accepts no responsibility for items lost due to theft or breakage.
8. IOWA CITY PRIDE makes no representation or guarantees towards actual festival attendance.
9. Pride Market participants understand that IOWA CITY PRIDE has no control over weather, acts of God, acts of terrorism, or governmental intervention, or any other cause that may prevent, and or interrupt, the festival, and participants shall hold not IOWA CITY PRIDE responsible for any losses that could arise because of such event.
10. IOWA CITY PRIDE reserves the right to place Pride Market participants in a booth location at the complete discretion of IOWA CITY PRIDE. Pride Market participants may request a preference of placement, however, IOWA CITY PRIDE shall have sole and complete authority to place the participant in any location contained in the Market Place, irrespective of the participant's request.
11. Any Pride Market participant who desires access to electrical current must request such access no later than May 26, 2004. Failure to provide notice of electrical service request, shall result in the participant's placement in a booth with no electrical service, and no guarantee of IOWA CITY PRIDE ability to provide such service.

Any modification of this agreement shall be null and void unless said modification is set forth in writing and signed by the same parties (or his/her representatives) having signed this agreement made on this _____ day of _____, 2004. This agreement has been read, understood and entered into freely, voluntarily and absent of duress by the parties signed below.
